This was given to Grace when home in 1927. This paper shows the details of Father's life, (William O. Hunt). His mother's name was Sophia A. Hunt. His father's name was Orson Hunt.

This Union, bore 5 boys and 4 girls, and their names are: Gertrude, William Orson, Emma, Sarah Jane, Frank, Alfrea F., Ida M., Levi, Charles.

<u>William 0. Hunt</u>, was born in Rodman Village, Jefferson Co. New York State on January 22nd, $\frac{19}{100}$. William was 5 years old when he moved with his parents, to Winslow Ill., and lived here 14 years. When William was 18 years, he married <u>Miss</u>. <u>Elizabeth Deniels</u>, in the year 1868. They moved to Missouri for $1\frac{1}{2}$ years, and then went back to Ill. for $2\frac{1}{2}$ years. Then they moved to Wisconsin for 6 years, and from there to Maynard Iowa, for 27 years. From there, they moved to Minnesota $1\frac{1}{2}$ years, and then, on to North Bakota, in 1902. To this union, was born 9 children, and of those, 2 died in infancy. <u>William</u>, was <u>converted</u> into the <u>Christian Faith</u>, in <u>1924</u> in the Methodist Church at <u>Rurch</u>, North Dakota.

Elizabeth Daniels

Details of my Mother's life. (Elizabeth Daniels). Her Father's name was <u>George</u> <u>W. Daniels</u>, and her Mother's name was <u>Marriet H. Daniels</u>. She had 3 sister's and 4 brothers, and one died in infancy. <u>Mrs Hunt</u>, the only surviving one (<u>Elizabeth</u> <u>Daniel's</u>), she was born at Wolf Creek, Lafayette Co. Wisconsin, on <u>February 16th</u>, 1847. <u>Elizabeth</u>, lived there till she was 20 years old, and then she married, <u>Willist O. Funt</u> in 1663. They moved to Linneus-Lyme Co. Mo. after they were married. Unto this union, was born <u>9 children</u>, and they were: <u>Almina</u>, <u>Valson W., George E., Gertie May.</u>, <u>Daisy House</u>, <u>Sidney A.</u>, <u>Dulsey A.</u>, <u>Orace V.</u>, <u>Rollo S</u>.

My mother, (Elizabeth Daniels), was converted into the Christian Faith, when she was 19 years old, and was united to the Methodist Church, at Rural, North Dakota.

This is the written copy we received from my sister (Grace, Hunt Taylor), when we were in California, in 1941.

Orson Eliza Hunt

The following was found among papers of Sarah Hunt Wire Sinclair:

Orson Eliga Hunt was born in Boston, Mass., Sept. 29th, 1827. He died Mar. 8, 1893 being 65 years, 5 months and 8 days at time of death. In the year 1843 he moved to Rodman, N. Y.. He was married Sept. 11, 184- to Miss Sophia Augusta Vaughn of Clayton, Jefferson Co., N. Y. They moved to Winslow, Ill., where they have resided ever since. They had 9 children born into this union, 8 of whom survive them. Sophia born Mar. 9, 1829 - died Jan. 20, 1919. They are buried in Rock Lily Cemetary, Winslow, Ill..

A note on the reverse side reads: For Aunt Sarah . The sheet of paper is aged and brown; it can hardly be read with a magnifying glass. It remained in the possession of Sarahs' son Earl Sinclair in 1976.

An obituary published in The Daily Journal, Vol 15, No. 50, Freeport, IL

County Cullings, Winslow

Winslow, March 6 - Orson Hunt died Monday evening at 7 o'clock. He had been sick only a few days and refused to have a physician called until Monday morning, when it was too late. At present writing the cause of his death is unknow. The funeral will probably be held Wednesday or Thursday.

The 1850 census of Rodman, Jefferson Co., NY and the 1880 census of Winslow, Stephenson Co., IL also give his birthplace as MA. The 1860 census of Stephenson Co., IL gives it as NY. Research to positively establish his parentry has been unsuccessful.

A search of printed genealogies by Lawrence Zuehlke has established a possible connection in the book, <u>Genealogy of the Hunt Family</u> by T. B. Wyman, Jr., Boston: John Wilson & Son, 1862-3. On page 357 covering miscellaneous branches of the family HUNT of LongMeadow-

Willard Hunt, son of Jesse of Stafford, Conn., m., 1. Electa who ob. Nov. 19, 1842, a. 48; 2. May 3, 1843, Salley Stacy of Monson, who ob. ; 3. Oct. 4, 1851, Orinda Ramsdell (her third marriage also), dau. of W. Hayward. Issue, Alonzo, April 12, 1820; Cyndonia, Dec. 19, 1822; Lydia Ann Jennett, April 20, 1825; Orion Elisha, Sept. 29, 1826; Delia Ann, June 5, 1829; Orrin, March 8, 1831. Mr. Hunt was of Monson, and age stated 52 in 1851.

On page 363 of the same book is the following entry:

William Hunt and wife Electa had Cindonia born at Jenksville; ob. a 22 y 5 m April 24, 1845.

A copy of the birth record from town of Longmeadow, Hampden Co. , MA reads:

Search of the records of Willard Hunt has not further established his connection to Orson Hunt of Rodman, NY or Winslow, IL. For further information concerning this family see Appendix

Thru census, newspaper, county histories and family records we have been able to establish some of the descendants of Orson and Sophia HUNT. Of their personal life we wish we knew more. Many of the hardships they faced is told in the history of the frontier settlement of our nation. It is further expressed in the obituary of Sophia Hunt which reads:

Sophia Augusta Vaughn was born at Clayton, Jefferson Co., New York, March 9th, 1828, and departed this life January 20th, 1919, aged 90 years, 10 months and 11 days. She was united in marriage with Orson Elijah Hunt, Sept. 11th, 1845, at Rodman, N. Y., where they resided until May 1854. Mr. Hunt departed this life March 6, 1893.

To this union there were born 9 children, 7 of whom are still living. Mr. and Mrs. Hunt were of the early pioneers of Winslow township, coming here in the spring of 1854. She has lived continuously in this township for 65 years, having witnessed the remarkable progress and development of the country. She heard the howl of the

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wolf and coyote, the stealthy tread of the bounding deer, and saw the Indian trail of the prairie give place to the sturdy homesteader and the public highway, also the passing of the crude sickle, the cradle and ox-team to the present motor tractor and buzzing auto, and the many inventions that seemed almost impossible 90 years agoshe has seen them become a reality.

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She knew something of the privations, self denial and economy of the early days; her life was spent principally on the farm devoid the many modern inventions that made farm life a thing to be desired. A mother of 9 children - many a night she kept a lone watch by the side of the suffering ones and ministered as best she could to their needs, for she loved her children. Think of the years of hard toil, the ministry of the hands, the service she gave in the home for the welfare, happiness and comfort of her children. She gave her best - Love. The home was her realm and to these occupants there will rise before them the star of kindness, goodness called - Mother. They will be able to say: "I've looked on hands whose form and hue, a sculptor's dream might be; yet are my mother's wrinkled hands more beautiful to me."

Mrs. Hunt was able to be about and help in the home until very recently, when she laid down quietly and consciously fell asleep to awake in God's spiritual universe.

She leaves besides her seven children, thirty-nine grandchildren, sixty- great grandchildren, besides many relatives and friends who will miss her...

Funeral services were held on Friday afternoon and interment was made in Rock Lily cemetery.

The legal description of the property of Orson Hunt in Winslow is given in the Inventory of his estate - Box 111 Stephenson Co., Ill., which reads:

80 acres located W 1 SW 2 of Sec. 28, Twnsp 29, N Range 6, E of 4PM containing dwelling house, granary & stable, valued at \$3200

A further inventory of his estate indicates he had acquired some of the tools of farming - listings included a back eye binder, a mower, a hay rack and fork, a riding plow, and a top buggy. There were 2300 bushels of oats in the granary. Among the livestock were 5 - 2 yr old steers, 1 bull 3 yrs old, 6 cows, 4 - 2 yr old Heefers, and 8 horses. The value of the may numerous listings of this chattel property was given as \$120.

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Of Orsons; personal habits we know very little. It was remembered that he "drank" quite heavily. The mention in his obituary that he refused medical attention until too late would probably indicate that he was the ruling force in his home. Family sentiment has been passed down with the generations that the love and affection of the children for the mother expressed in the obituary was real and not just the flowery expression of the time.

In the following genealogy of their descendants, we have attempted to trace both male and female lines. The information we have is far from complete. Primarily we have traced the families of son William Orson Hunt and the daughter Sarah Jane Hunt from which we are descendants. Hopefully someday additonal information may be added.

William Orson Hunt was born January 22, 1849 at Rodman Village, Jefferson Co., New York, and was one of nine children to be born to Orson Elijah Hunt and Sophia A. Vaughn. In May 1854 the family moved to Winslow, Illinois. He, and his four brothers and four sisters, spent their early years on the family farm there.

When he was nineteen years old, William married Elizabeth Daniels of neighboring Lafayete Co., Wisconsin. During the first years of their marriage they located and relocated many times. Their first child, Almina, was born in Missouri where they remained for about a year and half. They then returned to Illinois where their sons Valson and George were born. Gertie and Daisey were born in Misconsin where they remained about six years. The remaining children were born in Town where they lived for about 23 years.

In 1901 they decided to move to Minnesota, but within a 11 decided to go on to North Dakota. Williams borther Levi and son George accompanied him. Wm homesteaded the southeast quarter of section 28 - township 136 north of range 83 - west of fifthe prime meridan at Flasher, North Dakota. His first home there was a sod cabin. He followed this with a well and a stone granary. . Later he replaced the sod cabin with a frame house.

In subsequent years, his sons Sidney and Rollo, took up adjoining homesteads northeast of Flasher. His daughter Grace, married Andrew Taylor in 1906 and homesteaded south of Flasher. In 1909, his daughter Daisey Leonard, with son Levi, and daughters Lucy and Gertie, took a homestead adjoining her father. The daughter Almina remained in Iowa and son Valson in Minnesota.

The family maintained close ties. This was the age when large families were no burden. They all worked hard and shared the harvest of their labors. They weathered North Dakota dust storms and the battle with grasshoppers. North Dakota was now their home.

Some of the little things remembered by his Grandsons' Levi Leonard wife Brenda were

1. The advent of his new threasing machine with which Grandpa did threashing for his neighbors and was paid.

2. The cave in at the coal mine where Levis' Uncle Georges leg was injured -Grandma Hunt had said she wasn"t surprised - she had spiritual knockings on the head of the bed the night before he was born.

3. Dentists wern't plentiful, near at hand, or was there much money -Grandpa and Grandma both lost all of their teeth. Their gums became very hard and they could eat about anything. They both loved to chew gum - large wads of it.

4. Grandma had skin cancer removed from her lip in 1918 and nose about 1922. The resultant scar to her lip was about like hare lip surgery.

5. Like most parents: they had their favorites - Grandpa being partial to Daisey and Grandma to George. Rollo, the baby, fought with his Dad about a lot of things, but got along well with his fathers brother Levi: Grace and her husband Andrew were probably the most refined and social of the family. They were always very close to the church and each other. Grandma had trouble getting along with son Sids first wife Maud, who always spoke rather hateful about Grandma. Both Grandma and Grandma were very good to Levi and Brenday who lived with them the first two years after their marriage. William Hunt continued to live on his homestead until 1930, when he moved in with his son George until his death March 17, 1932. He had been sich about 2 weeks and death was not unexpected. However death did not come as reported in the flowery obituary of his time. He was not a retigious man eatroting praises to God, or was there a wave of his hand to his family. The family was gathered in the kitchen and they made frequent trips to hia bedside to check on him, and it was on one of these trips that they discovered he had passed away. His wife Elizabeth, then moved to Flasher to be with her daughter, Daisey Leonard House. She remained there until her death April 12, 1935. 4.2.1. Almina HUNT (Wm, Orson) b. Dec 1869 in Mo., m. Levi William Leonard

Compiled by his daughter Alice Leonard Vogelsang from information related by his wife Brenda Partridge Leonard and his sister Gertrude Hancock in 1972-73.

Levi Leonard was born Nov. 19, 1894 (a) in Maynard, Iowa. He was the 1st child of Francis Marion Leonard and Daisey Bell Hunt. His sister Lucy was born the following year and his sister Gertrude in 1898. His father left the family in 1898, and he grew up with the dream that maybe someday they would again meet. He learned the story of his fathers' disappearance from his Grandmother Elizabeth Hunt, but she only knew that possibly he had gone south - where his sisters lived.

His mother moved to Minnesota with him and his sisters to keep house for her brather George. The following spring her father sold his farm in Iowa and also moved to Minnesota. He only remained a year and the family decided to move on to North Dakota to take up homesteads. His son Wm Valson and Daisey remained in Iowa. In 1903 Daisey followed her Father to N. Dak. with the children. When her brother Georges home was ready she took Levi and Lucy and went to keep house for him.. Gertie remained at Grandpa and Grandmas'homestead. In 1908 George married and Daisey took up her own homestead, just a short way from her brother and father.(b) Gertie moved home to be with her brother, sister and mother.

Levi and his sisters attended the rural school. The school term was seven months, but frequently there was not five children of school age, so the school was not opened. Levi received only an elementary school education.

A lot of responsibility febl on Levi as man of the house. His grandfather, William Hunt, his Uncles Sid and George and Graat Uncle Levi Hunt all stood by and gave him help as he needed it. A good deal of the farming was done on a cooperative basis.

His sister Lucy married in 1913, and he also began to think of romance. However it wasn't until Feb. 1916 that he met the girl he eventually married. She was boarding with his Uncle Sid and teaching school, he had come by to help his Uncle haul hogs to Elasher. But the First World War came,

and July 17, 1917 (c) he joined the navy; postponing any immediate plans. He wrote to the girl back home.

while he was in the service his sister Gertie married, and his mother cold the homestead and married Henry House.He was discharged June 1919(d), and returned to his Grandfathers farm. He didn't waste much time before proposing to his girl. It wasn't an exciting proposal. Actually his . Girl had presumingly come over to his Grandparents farm to visit his sister. He found her alone in the kitchen and asked her if she thought they could be happy together. After he explained that actually he was proposing she answered"yes", and he kissed her for the first time.

On Sept. 1. 1920 Levi William Leonard and Brenda Emma Partridge were married in Solon, N. Dak. (e). The first two years after they were married they lived with his Grandparents. Their first child was born June 27, 1921. It was a son they affectionately called Sonny Boy. He died that fall.

Brenda continued to teach school until after the birth of their second child, Jeannette Lucille, born July 19, 1922. By then Levis' Great Uncle Levi Hunt had moved to Grary, Indiana and they moved over onto his farm.

A third child arrived August 23, 1923. They mamed her Eldean Lynette. It was about this time that Levi began to have real trouble with the circulation in his legs. When his third daughter arrived on August 9, 1927 he opent many days lying on the bed entertaining little Ardus Jean. To add further to his problems the country was now in a state of depression and farm prices were lower then ever before. After his fourth daughter, Alice Noelle, was born on February 1, 1931 he moved his family to Mandan.

Levi began making frequent trips to the Veterans Hospital in Chicago, Illinois as the pain and ulceration of his left leg and foot increased. During the time of his service in the navy he had complained of discomfort so severe that at times he was unable to stand watch. This condition was diagnosed as Buerger's Disease that had been aggravated by the tight elastic in the

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less of his Navy uniform. Gangrene continued to spread and in 1936 it ms necessary to amputate his feft leg and the great toe of his right foot. The healing was slow, and for several years he continued doctoring. The condition was service connected and he was granted a pension.

when he was finally able to work Levi supplimented his pension by selling matkins products. He had a special hand stick put into his car to depress the clutch so he could drive. He also put wheels onto a stool so he could sit and cut hair. He had been.trained as ships barber in the navy. He may able to work up a small business in his home, and in 1937 he took the state barbers examination at Jamestown, N.D. so he could work in one of the barber shops downtown.

wenda went back to teaching in 1943, so they could buy a home. She calified for this by taking a written examination for a Second Grade Rementary Certificate. This only enabled her to teach in the rural schools. Levi drove her back and forth every day if possible. This meant cetting her there early during the winter months, so they could fire up the gld coal stove to have the school warm before the first student errived.

The home they bought was located at 1006 3rd Street So. West, Mandan, N.D.. Although they paid it off in a couple years, Brenda continued to teach until 1949. At this time Levi bought a barber shop in New Salem. However plans to sell the home and move to New Salem never materized because Levis' health began to fail. He sold the shop in New Salem, and when his health permitted he worked part time at a shop in Mandan. He loved being with people and enjoyed the contacts he made through barbering.

Levi never let the loss of his leg be a handicap. At the time of his death he had climbed up onto the roof of the Baptist Church. He was heping the minister, who was a neighbor, to put up the cross. The date was October 3, 1955.
